The ten spent 25 cal. "Win" cartridge cases, items #2 thru #9, #13, #17, were microscopically compared to each other. All were fired in the same weapon (type unknown at this time).

The spent 25 cal. bullets, items #11, #10, #14, #15, #19, #20, #22 and #23, were examined microscopically and found to have 6 lands and 6 grooves with a right hand twist. Among the weapons possible are the following semiautomatics: 1. Titan

- 2. F.I.E
- 3. E.I.G
- 4. Hawes

Note: All spent bullets were fired from the same weapon:

The clothing item #25, belonging to female victim was examined microscopically for traces of gunshot residue. None was detected. Chemical tests for the presence of lead and nitrites were performed. Traces of nitrites (one of the components of gunshot residue) were found around a apparent bullet hole in the front of a red sweatshirt. A traget to muzzle distance cannot be determined until a suspect weapon is submitted. The clothing of the male victim was microscopically examined for traces of gunshot residue. None was detected. Chemical tests for gunshot residue were performed on each suspected bullet hole. The results were negative..
