8:40 p.m. Kaley and Doak drove Bill LeFever to his office located in Alliance. Bill showed Kaley and Doak the Hartig's Insurance records. Bill said Cora would walk him to the house. They always conducted their business at the kitchen table.

9:40 p.m. Kaley and Doak drove Bill Le Fever to Hartig's residence, 6593 Moff Road, Atwater, Ohio, where Bill went over Insurance papers that were at the house. During the interview approximately 10:05 p.m. Kaley read Bill LeFever, his Miranda Warning. Bill understood and Kaley advised Bill he was free to leave, that he was not under arrest. Bill stated that a Bob Gallagher introduced him to Lewis Lehman. Bill said at one time he helped Mr. Lehman with auto and home owners insurance. This would have been like a training time. Bill said that Lewis Lehman never got through the training program. During the interview Kaley asked Bill if Lehman ever carried a gun. Bill said Lewis Lehman had a 25 automatic that he carried in his vehicle. He kept it in the center console of his vehicle. Bill said that Lehman showed him the gun one night when they were out together. This was in 1986. Bill stated Lehman's hair was dark and short. He did not remember for sure about the length. Was not long, hair was dark. Bill said that Lehman was short, sort of on the heavy side. Bill said Lehman was around 50 years of age. Kaley asked Bill if he had his house financed. Bill said he did and that he had his home up for sale. Reason for this, they had some problems with one of the neighbors. Bill asked if we suspected Lewis Lehman. Kaley explained to Bill that we had to interview anyone that had contact with the Hartigs.

Bill told Kaley that Lehman used to much pressure when he made a sale and he did not care for his way of selling insurance. Bill told Kaley the last time he had seen the Hartigs was when they changed vehicles.
